

# WORLD BUILDING FOR NOVELS

The Bible says God created the world in six days, but if you're writing a novel, it can take longer.

The trick is to get organized—by writing your own Bible.

Every novelist's Bible will be different. Maybe mine will spark some ideas.



## **SCRIBOPHILE SAYS THIS:**

**Worldbuilding** is the step in the writing process when a writer **establishes the parameters** of their fictional world.

This includes the sort of **people** who live in the world, what their **day-to-day lives** look like, their **beliefs**, and the way they've been shaped by their **ecosystem**, **geography**, and **history**.

# MY TAKE: START WITH BASICS

- Focus on what matters for your plot and characters.
- Establish the fundamentals Consider the physical world first: geography, climate, and how these shape where people live and how they survive.
- Then think about the social structures—
  government systems, economic foundations,
  cultural values, and belief systems. These
  elements should influence each other naturally.



# **ADD THE LOGIC OF THE WORLD**

- Create consistent rules, whether you're writing fantasy with magic systems or science fiction with advanced technology.
- Establish limitations and consequences. If magic exists, what can it do and what does it cost? If there's faster-than-light travel, how does it work and how does it affect society?



# **ADD POV CONSIDERATIONS**

- Show your world through how your characters interact with it. A farmer will notice different details than a merchant or a soldier. Let their backgrounds and concerns reveal the world's aspects naturally.
- Layer in history. Past events shape current conditions. Wars, disasters, discoveries, and cultural shifts leave marks on language, architecture, social tensions, and traditions.
- You may need detailed timelines.



# **ADD ROOM FOR DISCOVERY**

- Keep notes, but don't overplan.
- Document important details for consistency but leave room for discovery as you write.
- Sometimes the best worldbuilding emerges organically from the story itself.
- The key is making your world feel lived-in rather than constructed—a place where people have real problems, relationships, and daily concerns that go beyond your main plot.



## MY SPIN ON NOVEL BIBLE - I

- Add meta-documents and ideas
  - Premise
  - Themes
  - Atmospherics
  - Back-cover blurb (options)
  - Genre
  - Synopsis, logline, tagline
- Achieve end-to-end consistency
  - Spellings of characters, place names, organizations, artifacts/technologies, etc.
  - Character appearance, manner of speaking, skills, way of thinking
  - Settings descriptions and details Including drawings, pictures
  - Backstory, origins, histories



## MY SPIN ON A NOVEL BIBLE - II

- Establish character profiles
  - Pictures (I use actors as stand-ins for characters)
  - Psychological profile
  - Backstory and timelines
- Plot Outline
- Character and event timelines
- Maps
- Tech / magic system, artifact purpose, operation
- Genealogy
- Comp Titles
- Cover Art
- Chapter Summary



## **CHARACTER PROFILES**

#### Berky Benson


- Bald, chunky
- Has the manners and motives of a moonshiner
- Whip-smart
- Berky was the grown-up boy Nadia taught in high school, son of Lionel Benson,
   committed to an institution for the criminally insane at age 35 and stayed there until his death.
- Then there was Gloria Benson, Berky's mother, who nursed him through the bad times, made sure he went to school, and tried to interest him in her single, intellectual passion—the Dear Abby column. That was another narrative thread.
- Finally, whenever she greeted Berky, she saw his extraordinary brain—a brain that absorbed every bit of data she threw at him in science class and spun it in a peculiar way. Berky was brilliant, creative and, she had to admit, insane.
- As a fan of Dear Abby, he was obsessed with making a perfect world. Oddly, he was oblivious to human relationships. He would look for the structure of paradise in the electric motors he tinkered with, the animals he dissected, the homemade explosives he detonated, and the journals he kept.







#### COMPARISON WITH THE PIECES OF MY SELF:

#### Similarities with *Pieces*:

- Noir-ish tone.
- The backdrop is a water crisis.

#### Differences with *Pieces*:

- Focused on the scramble for water and water rights in the American southwest (vice the rising water levels of the U.S. Gulf Coast).
- The protagonist is a cynical hitman with few human ties (vice a sarcastic woman mathematician obsessed with the safety of her two children).
- It is about money (vice "blood").

## Don't Forget Revision Control


- Your story and world will evolve as you build it




